We are so happy to have all children back to nursery. Thank you for your patience over the past few months as we continue to work through these unusual times. We know that it can be frustrating that things are not as they used to be in nursery and there are times when we have had to follow guidance from Test and Protect with regards to children isolating but please be assured everything we do is for the safety of all. At Penilee Nursery we are following the health and safety guidelines from Scottish Government as well as Glasgow City Council's health and safety department. **This includes wearing masks outwith playrooms and adults keeping a 2 metre distance from each other.** Whilst in the playrooms with children adults do not wear masks or distance themselves from children, only other adults. Given this there may be times due to children being in close contact with each other and with adults that there is a need for Test and Protect measures to be put in place. Please be assured everything we do is with the guidance of Public Health. Should you have any questions with regards to our Risk Assessments please do not hesitate to ask.

The leads in each Forest meet regularly to ensure the key teaching and learning in Numeracy, Literacy and Health and Wellbeing is being cascaded throughout the whole nursery.

Please note all staff provide all children with learning experiences to cover all areas of the curriculum.

Teaching and Learning- As all children return to nursery the main focus will be to ensure they feel safe and secure in their nursery environment. Staff will be spending time with children settling them back into the nursery environment offering fun planned learning experiences initially to promote literacy, numeracy and health and wellbeing. Staff will be observing children for the rest of the month to identify interests to focus on when delivering learning experiences.

Changes of Clothes for your Child- As all children may get wet due to taking part in water play or having a toileting accident you must ensure that you provide several changes of clothes (Tops, bottoms, pants and socks). Please check your child's bag daily to make sure they have enough clothes. We do not have any spare clothes in the nursery to use for children. This will also save any inconvenience that may be caused by calling you to bring clothes to the nursery for your child.

Requests for August 2021 placements- A form to request adjustments of nursery placement for August 21 will be given out next week. This will allow you to make a request for changes to your child's placement should you wish. Please complete and return these as soon as possible.
