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What we are learning about:

Numeracy



In Number, Primary 1 will be continuing to focus on numbers between 0 and 20. We will be learning to use our knowledge of numbers to find 1 more and 1 less. We will be learning to name and describe various 2D shapes and 3D objects. We will be able to cut an object in half and also match halves to make whole shapes. This term we will introduce money, the children will be learning to recognise the value of each coin. Please give your child as many opportunities to use money when visiting the shops.

Literacy

In Literacy, the children will continue to learn initial sounds and common words and apply these in Reading and Writing. When reading a story, we will be learning to retell the main events in our own words. Within Writing, we will be learning to have a go at our own sentences through personal and descriptive writing. We will also be looking at the skills of Short Talk in Listening and Talking. The children will be learning to introduce their topic of choice, give information and then finish their talk by

Health and Wellbeing

We are learning the importance of physical activity and keeping healthy. Within PE we will be focusing on Gymnastics and Dance where we will follow and create a series of dance steps. We will continue to look at emotions and explore different behaviours associated with each emotion.

Things to remember...

Sounds & Words: We are learning new sounds and words every week, please continue to support your child in learning these as they will build a good foundation for reading and writing.

PE: Our PE days are Tuesday and Wednesday. Please ensure that your child has a full Gym kit and no jewellery as due to Health and Safety reasons they will then not be able to take part.

Home Learning: Your child should bring their Home Learning folder to school with them every Friday to allow time for folders to be updated and handed back out on a Monday. Home Learning is a mix of activities and reading from the Home Learning folder and activities on Seesaw. This is to ensure a variety of tasks to make Home Learning enjoyable for your child.
