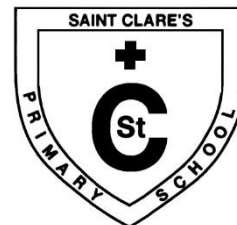

What we are learning about:

Numeracy



Primary 1 will develop their knowledge of:

- Addition and subtraction by finding one more and one less than a given number of objects. We will also recognise and read the +, - and = symbols.
- Fractions by recognising and identifying halves and quarters of shapes.
- Money by identifying coins up to £2 and putting them in order of value.

Primary 2 will develop their knowledge of:

- Addition and subtraction by using number bonds to 20 and counting on/back.
- Fractions by identifying and making halves and quarters.
- Money by recognising, naming and ordering coins to £2. We will also explore the different ways to make the same amounts of money.

Pupils will have regular opportunities to continue developing their counting skills, and reading and writing numbers from 0-20 and beyond.

Literacy

Primary 1 will focus on:

Reading

- We will continue to develop our knowledge of sounds in the alphabet by reading, naming and blending them together to read simple words.
- We will continue to develop our sight word knowledge.

Writing

- We will use our learning about sounds to form letters with accuracy and 'have a go' at writing sentences independently.

Talking and Listening

- Children will develop their skills in Short Talk to complete short presentations to the class.

Primary 2 will focus on:

Reading

- We will develop our understanding of using before, during and after reading strategies to help us understand a text.
- We will also continue to develop our knowledge of sounds and sight words.

Writing

- We will learn to write an information report as well as recounts of events.

Talking and Listening

- Children will develop their skills in Short Talk to complete short presentations to the class.

Health and Wellbeing

In PE we are currently working on dance. In class we will be looking at different feelings and expressing emotions through various activities.

Religious Education

We will continue exploring the Bible stories as well as celebrating religious events in the liturgical calendar. Preparations for our Nativity have also commenced. We will continue to practise our Mass responses.
