#### **Industrial Action**

Next Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> January there is scheduled industrial action and the school will be closed to all pupils. There is further action planned for Monday 16<sup>th</sup> January. Dear Parent/Carer

#### School closures update due to ongoing industrial action – 10, 11 & 16 January 2023

I wrote to you before the end of term about the next round of industrial action that has been called by several teacher unions and I said I would update you when the schools went back.

Unfortunately, there has been no change to the planned strikes and because we have no certainty on how many teachers will report for work, we have been left with no option but to close schools to pupils on the following days:

Tuesday 10 January 2023: All Primary schools, including ASL primary schools (Secondary schools open as normal)

Wednesday 11 January 2023: All secondary schools, including ASL secondary schools (Primary schools open as normal)

#### Monday 16 January 2023 - Primary and Secondary schools, including ASL schools.

Our intention is that nursery classes and standalone nurseries will open as normal.

I apologise once again for a situation that is beyond the Council's control, since pay negotiations take place at a national level. I know that having to make alternative arrangements so soon into the new term is difficult for families.

Details of free school meal payments for eligible families to cover the strike days will be posted on our website in the next few days.

We will continue to keep you informed as soon as we have any new information and will update the Council's normal communication channels.

## Parking in the School

Please be mindful of the children crossing the road at the back gate if dropping off your child. The back gate is not supervised by staff members in the morning and we are concerned that an accident could occur due to lack of awareness.

## Road Safety and Parking on Crompton Avenue/Safe Streets Campaign Reminder

A reminder that it is not permitted to drive down Crompton Avenue between 8.30-9.15am and 2.45-3.30pm as the school is part of a school free car zone scheme run by GCC. This has been in place since session 2019-2020. Please note that the Community Police have been issuing tickets throughout last session and will continue to support the school by reminding the public of the restrictions that are still in place and must be obeyed.

## **Car Park**

Please do not use the school carpark at any time for dropping off your child including breakfast club and after school (Exemptions for blue badge holders). Parents and children must use pedestrian areas only when accessing the school grounds. Other City Building staff drive through the main gate and will be unaware that parents have been incorrectly using this gate as a pedestrian walkway. This could have serious repercussions and result in an accident.

## **Outdoor PE**

Please ensure that on outdoor PE days children have appropriate clothing to keep them dry and warm. It would be advisable to provide a change of clothes in your child's bag in the event of them getting wet. We have a very limited supply in the school.

## **Health and safety**

Please ensure that your child does not bring electronic smart watches of any kind to school. A number of children have returned after Christmas with watches that can take pictures and/or record/film/facetime. This is not appropriate for use in school. In addition we are not insured for any

damages. Can we also request that no energy drinks, chewing gum or lollipops are brought in for snacks. Thank you for your support with this matter.
