Dear Parents and Carers,

Positive Case over holiday period

Current advice from the Education Directorate is as follows: If your child develops symptoms or tests positive after today you will not be able to contact the school. Instead you will be contacted by the Test and Protect team who will discuss the details with you and ask for the information they need. It is important if your child tests positive during the holidays and has to isolate beyond the school return date of Monday April 19th that you contact the school directly on that date as you would for any other absence.

<u>If anyone in your household has tested positive then all household members must get a</u> <u>coronavirus test</u>. Even if a negative result is returned for those family members, they **must still isolate.**
